

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

### WIRE CONNECTIONS TO DUAL CONTROL THERMOSTAT

#### REQUIRED ABILITY:

The installation of this kit requires the ability equivalent to that of a licensed tradesman in the field involved. Removal and installation of gas controls, plumbing, gas supply and electrical work are required.

**TURN OFF POWER SUPPLY TO HEATER BEFORE

The new controls, listed below, comply as of January 1, 1996 with required changes stated in the ANSI Z21.10.3-1993:

We have changed the two wire connector terminals for the Dual Control Thermostat from screw type connectors to Spade type connectors. The Male Spade terminals now accept the Female Wire connectors, supplied with these instructions. Refer to below illustration.

#### TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Wire Stripper/Crimper

#### PARTS INCLUDED:

- Two (2) Female Slide-on Connectors

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. TURN OFF HEATER ELECTRICAL SUPPLY.
2. Remove pre-existing spade connectors by cutting wire as close to spade as possible.
3. Strip back 1/4" insulation from the end of wire.
4. Attach new female connectors to wire ends securely.
